
ALBANIA


ARMENIA



AUSTRIA

It had an impact on smaller, still growing evangelical churches. News of sex scandals within the Catholic Church also negatively affected the perception of the church.


AZERBAIJAN

A very small amount of Azerbaijan people are Christians, and those who are, tend to face harassment by law enforcement, are threatened with large fines, and are unable to congregate due to strict regulations.


BELARUS

However, only a small number of people regularly attend a church service. Some pockets of Croatians haven't heard the Word of God, but the door is wide open to share the Good News with them.


CYPRUS


CZECHIA


GEORGIA


HUNGARY


KAZAKHSTAN


KOSOVO



LITHUANIA


MONTENEGRO


NORTH MACEDONIA

- + Pray for healing from centuries-long ethnic and religious hatred.



SLOVAKIA




UKRAINE
